ELECTION DAY WAS LABOR DAY

Last night we celebrated a great victory with the election of Jon Corzine as New Jersey's Governor. With issues such as job creation, health care reform, retirement security, and property tax relief weighing so heavily on the minds of working families across the State, there is no doubt that we elected the right candidate for the job. In Jon Corzine we elected a public servant who has achieved a 100% working family voting record in the U.S. Senate, a leader with the ability to move our State forward, and a Statesman who will crush the culture of corruption many feel currently plagues our government.

In addition to Jon Corzine's electoral success, we are proud of the success of our endorsed candidates running for the New Jersey State Senate and General Assembly, especially our four union brothers who won their races. Over the course of their two-year terms we will work aggressively with these Assembly members to ensure that the issues that are important to our labor family get the full attention they deserve.
