Important elections will take place all across our state in the next few months. We encourage all union members and family to be registered to vote and to fully participate in each. Election laws have changed and it has never been easier to register to vote or cast a ballot in New Jersey.

To register, an applicant can submit a paper application or complete the form online. To cast a ballot, a voter may choose to vote-by-mail, vote early at an Early Vote Center, or on Election Day at their traditional polling place. Voting takes place over 45 days ending at 8:00 pm on Election Day.

**April School Board Elections:** are taking place in about a dozen municipalities within Bergen, Essex, Hudson, Middlesex and Passaic counties.
