As labor leaders, it is our duty to make sure that each and every registered union member, their coworkers, family and friends know that we can vote by mail, early or on Election Day. In New Jersey, the ballot has never been more accessible and voting more convenient.

Vote-by mail: Download, print, complete application, and deposit in mailbox. A ballot will be mailed to the voter. The voted ballot must be postmarked or placed into a secure ballot drop box by the voter within the voter's home county by 8:00 pm on November 8.

Vote Early: Visit any Early Vote Center within your county October 29- November 6. Hours will be Monday-Saturday 10:00 am-8:00 pm and Sunday 10:00 am-6:00 pm. No appointment is necessary.

Vote on Election Day: Traditional Polls open 6:00 am-8:00 pm on November 8, Election Day.


